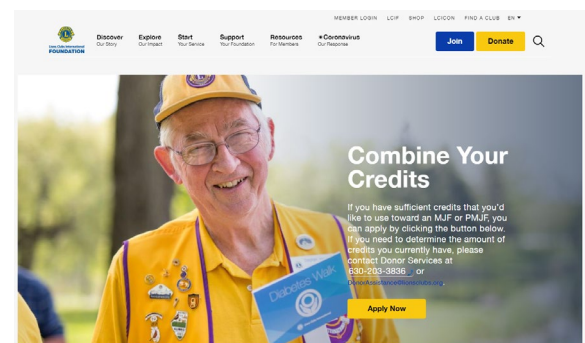
DISTRICT 1J GOLF OUTING

She has also volunteered at Turkey Trot through the years.

The focus of the Safe and Sound Program is to provide out of school programming for children. They traditionally serve 1200 children before and after school. They provide help with homework and various activities and playtime. This program is provided free of charge to families.

During COVID, Erika has been working with Edward Hospital to provide childcare for their essential workers. Through this program, they have been able to work with schools to enable remote learning with the students. They were also fed meals during their time and provided with other activities.

YMCA has been offering summer camps this year, but it is very different than before. There are no field trips or swimming. The children are organized into small groups and multiple safety precautions are taken.

Erika is currently working with the school districts and trying to coordinate further programming for the upcoming school year.
